1) Minutes of Previous Meetings

Hadley read minutes aloud for December 17, 2018
Motion to accept minutes as read voted 3-0 accept

2) Public Forum

Earl Hughes stated that the Town Manager and the Selectmen are very unprofessional. He sighted various instances where each has made comments that the HEAT group thought we were unprofessional and called it "conduct unbecoming professionals" Judy apologized for her instance and said that we are all human and we all make mistakes

Debbie Cooper wanted to know why it takes two and three emails to get information from us. Chris explained that we work for the entire Town not just the HEAT group's agenda and we prioritize the work day to day as necessary to serve more than a small group of people

Debbie asked why we didn't have contracts with all the haulers for the landfill as she feels it is irresponsible. Chris explained that the Landfill is a service business and many of the haulers only come one or two times. She then asked how we know what they are hauling. Chris explained that we follow our Landfill License that has specific processes for each product we accept.

3) Unfinished Business

Earl Hughes discussed a Sewer Abatement that he doesn't agree with from 2017

Hadley read a letter from the State of Maine Agricultural department regarding the animals on Blake Street. The letter states that there is no issue and that the State considers the case closed

Chris updated the Selectmen that the tear down of the Old Town Hall is complete

Reported that the Title search should be completed this week for the Hartland Consolidated School

Chris shared that we need to nominate a Spirit of America recipient soon
