- 1.) Minutes of Previous Meeting – Chris didn't bring minutes from 5/16/16

- 2.) Public Forum – Asked what would happen with the Gazebo and the Veteran benches after Bangor Savings closed....Chris responded that we owned the land that the Gazebo is on, but not the benches....it was suggested that the bank give us that land that the benches are on

Three areas identified as safety hazards...Corner of Seekins and Blake st,
Corner of Sanfield Living Center, and Manhole on the Corner of
Commercial st.

It was suggested that we shut down the Vigue road next spring to everyday traffic

Asked if we sold the fire truck for more money...yes we did \$4000.00

Did we hire part time public works person and are they insured by worker's compensation....yes we did and they are covered by all insurances except health

Did we have a big crowd at our Comprehensive plan meeting...yes we did around 42 people

Landfill Chris mentioned that we had received approximately 150 ton of sludge from Anson Madison Sanitary District

Reviewed CEO's letter about repeat offenders of trash...Al suggests that we fine according to our ordinance up to \$2500/day.

Shared letter sent to Brenda Seekins from the Selectmen regarding cemeteries

4.) New Business

Motion made to abate Sewer bill due to leak in the amount of \$435 +/- voted 3-0 accept

5.) Other

Chris shared the progress at the HPCF project planning and how pleased he is with the new Engineering firm Olver Associates

Chris informed the Board that he applied for another loan forgiveness package of \$1,000,000 from the DEP which would be used in the Commercial street corridor

Chris reported that he is not applying for NBRC grant this year.

Motion made to enter executive session per 36 MRSA 841 (2) (E) for a poverty abatement Voted 3-0 accept

Motion made in public forum to accept the Town Manager's recommendation and accept the abatement voted 3-0 accept
